The Water Resources Center Archives provides a wide range of services and maintains an extensive collection of water related information. The collection primarily contains technical material with an emphasis on freshwater quality, wastewater treatment and water supply information. It also contains extensive materials on wetlands, estuaries and coasts. Our holdings of approximately 140,000 titles concentrate on California and the West; however, extensive material from all 50 states as well as international publications are also included. In addition to new material, our collection contains unique historical water-related maps and manuscripts donated by engineers and hydrologists who have contributed to the field of water resources development in California. Our holdings are included in Melvyl®, the University of California on-line catalog.

The library assists the UC Center for Water Resources by organizing, managing and disseminating information on water. The Archives is a University of California system-wide facility and is dedicated to making the information in the collection widely available. In general, reports published after 1970 may be loaned for the semester. Reference items, manuscripts, and other items published before 1970 must be used in the library. It is not necessary to have a UCB Library Card to borrow from the Archives, although patrons wishing to become registered borrowers must show valid identification.
